HOUSE RULES



The KörberHaus is an open place in Bergedorf.

People of all ages and cultures meet here.

Consideration, respect and a willingness to help are very important to us.

Our house rules are in place to ensure that we get along together.

PLEASE OBSERVE THESE RULES:



Talk to each other. Take care of each other and the building.



Be considerate of other people. Supervise your children during the visit.



Keep the building, its furnishings and outdoor facilities clean. Throw rubbish into the rubbish bins.



Use the bike stands to lock your bike.

The use of sports equipment is prohibited on the premises.



Smoking and the use of drugs are prohibited here. Alcohol consumption is only permitted at events.



Dogs and other animals are not allowed. Only assistance dogs are permitted.



You require written authorisation for the distribution and display of flyers. This also applies to photo, film or sound recordings.

OTHER REMINDERS:

You use the facilities and areas at the KörberHaus at your own risk. Familiarise yourself with the escape routes in the building and keep them clear.

By attending events at the KörberHaus, you agree that films and photos may be made and used by us.

We react with a ban or report to the police, especially in the following cases:

- distribution and posting of political party materials

- sale of services or goods without written authorisation
- wilful soiling, damage or misuse of the KörberHaus
